Earth Day – Colour Hunt







Resources

- What can you find on your daily walks or in your garden?
- A colour board, or coloured pieces of paper.

Instructions

First search for natural fallen objects in your garden or when on your daily walks. Try to look for lots of different colours. Lastly, match up the objects to the colour on your board or pieces of paper.

Learning Goals

This activity provides an opportunity to explore the natural environment whilst looking for your resources.

It enables children to think for themselves when matching up colours, therefore creating links as part of their characteristics of effective learning.

Allow your children to think for themselves where the objects may go and what colour they may match with, being there to support them if needed. You could talk about the properties and characteristics of the resources found, introducing new describing words.
