Identify isolation area close to entrance or outside         2. Isolation box to contain PPE mask, visor, apron, gloves, snack & water         3. Child showing symptoms will be immediately isolated         4. Staff member showing symptoms will be sent home         5. Staff member to sit with child wearing following PPE- Mask, visor, gloves, apron         6. Parents will be notified for immediate collection         7. Area to be deep cleaned following incident         8. Setting to be deep cleaned following confirmed case         9. All materials used to be double bagged and placed in refuse         10. Liaise with AM to ensure parent/staff communications are in place

Risk Colour	Condition	Further Action
Green	This is a low risk, but we will continue to monitor.	Carry out regular checks and inspections to ensure that this remains safe.
Amber	This is a medium risk, can we make it safer.	Take Reasonably Practicable measures to reduce the risk.
Red	This is a high risk, We need to make it safer before continuing.	Take urgent measures to reduce the risk. If necessary, cease the activity until the risks can be reduced.
