Resources

- ✓ A variety of different coloured toys/objects
- ✓ Coloured pieces of paper, coloured containers or cups, or similar
- ✓ Coloured spoons or scoops, (plain will also work)

Instructions

Firstly, lay out your coloured paper, containers or cups in a row. To one side place your coloured toys (see photos above for an idea of what we do at nursery) finally scatter some utensils to provide your child with choices. Some of your cooking utensils could be really fun to include in this activity

Learning Goals

This activity provide an opportunity to explore a few different colours at a time, for younger children this activity can be used to learn some simple colour names and practice fine motor skills by using the different tools.

For older children the activity promotes matching and categorising the colours they already know, as well as counting the objects and strengthening their fine motor skills.
