

Painting Rainbows

Resources: paper, different colour paints.

Learning Goals: This activity was set up after a child started talking about rainbows in the garden

Instructions: Have learning prompts and examples of what a rainbow looks like, but allow the child to take the lead and use their own imagination. Let them mix the colour and see how they change shades.

It doesn't matter if their picture does not look exactly like the rainbow, as long as they had fun! Talk about the rainbow and where it came from. Join in and make your own rainbow photo, role modelling how to use the tools and what language to use.
