

Exploring Animals

Resources: animals, books, natural found objects of different shapes and textures.

Learning Goals: This activity was set up for a child who shows an interest in animals and needed to further their concept on sizes.

Instructions: Allow the child to explore and observe to see what they take an interest in. If they especially like one toy or object, help them investigate this and extend their learning on that toy or object, for example what it represents, it's properties etc. If they really like the elephant, then focus your attention on the elephant and really help this interest of theirs grow. Use the book as a tool to further their learning experience and incorporate literacy into the activity, looking at the illustrations as you read the story to them.
