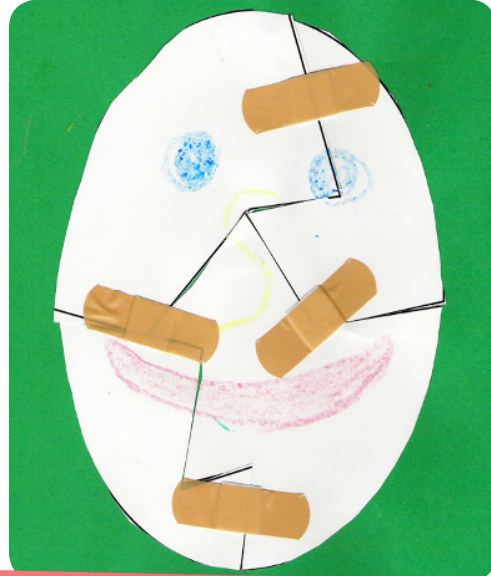

## Humpty Dumpty Puzzle

Prepare your egg-shaped paper or card, pencils or pens and plasters or tape. Encourage your child to draw Humpty Dumpty's face on their egg! You can use this as an opportunity to learn about different facial features and what we use them for. Either role model or encourage your child to cut their Humpty Dumpty to make their puzzle. Stick Humpty Dumpty back together again with your plasters or tape.
